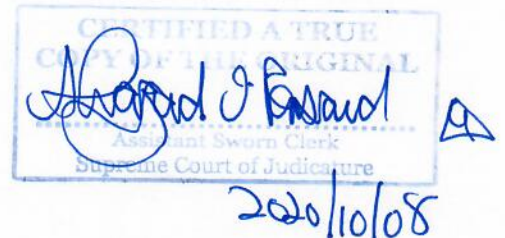

CONSENT ORDER



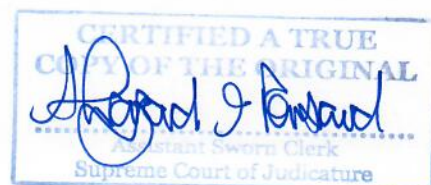
THIS APPLICATION, made by TROY THOMAS for judicial review was heard this 21st day of
September 2020 at the High Court, Georgetown.

ON READING the Fixed Date Application with Affidavit in support thereof sworn to by TROY THOMAS and dated 21st May 2020 with attendant exhibits, and on hearing the submissions of the Attorneys-at-Law for the Applicant, the Respondent and the Added Interested Party, who all confirmed that the parties have reached a settlement, at which hearing the parties agreed to settle the matter on the terms directed by Her Honour Madam Justice Barlow as follows:

- (a) The Respondent shall reduce the term of Environmental Permit 20160705-EEDPF for Liza Phase 1 (the “Liza 1 Permit”) to five years in accordance with Regulation 19 of the Environmental Protection (Authorisation) Regulations made under the Environmental Protection Act Cap 20:05 by amending the said Liza 1 Environmental Permit so that it expires on 1st June 2022.
- (b) The Respondent shall reduce the term of Environmental Permit 20171204-ESSLP for Liza Phase 2 (the “Liza 2 Permit”) to five years in accordance with Regulation 19 of the Environmental Protection (Authorisation) Regulations made under the Environmental Protection Act Cap 20:05 by amending the said Liza 2 Environmental Permit so that it expires on 25th April 2024.
- (c) In compliance with the orders at (a) and (b) hereof, the Respondent shall file with the Court copies of the amended Environmental Permits or new Environmental Permits, on or before the 8th October 2020.

THE COURT FURTHER ORDERS that: -

- a) the Respondent shall pay to the Applicant costs which costs shall be assessed by the Court.
- b) The Applicant shall make an Application for assessment of costs in accordance with Part 64:05 of CPR 2016 on or before 9th October 2020.



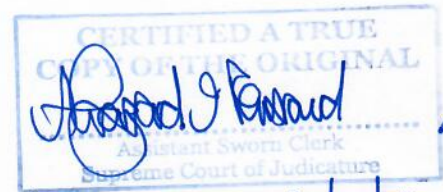
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c) The Respondent shall respond to the Application for assessed costs, (if necessary) on or before the 16th day of October 2020.
